As a mother myself I can relate to how Sara feels wanting to protect your child. When Lizzie tells her mother about this, Sara realizes that she needs to get to the bottom of why Billy is scared so her daughter doesn't have to have the nightmares anymore.

Protecting Lizzie's new friend becomes the focus of the adventure that Sara and Brian go on, diving into the dangerous world of shady politics and blackmail.

It really kept me guessing from start to finish. Although the author refers to her as a four year old, but sounds much more like a six to eight year old.
